Internal demolition on the Brunette Apartments building, our second location in Lawrence, is now complete. Although we have experienced some unexpected delays, plans are underway to create 38 apartments with completion slated in 2024.

We have welcomed many new faces to the Merici family, both staff and people we support. As we grow, I continue to be amazed by the quality of our staff and the beauty they reflect in the community.

Thank you for being a part of this journey with us. We invite you to keep in touch, watch the progress, and know that you play a role in transforming lives.

A wonderful year-end surprise!

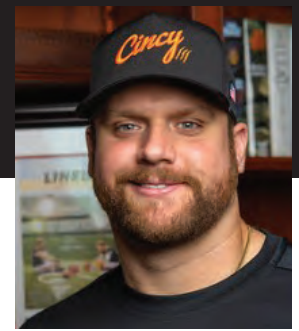
Ted Karras, NFL Center for the Cincinnati Bengals, and long-time friend of the Village of Merici came up with an amazing way to support our mission. Ted signed a four-year contract with the Bengals last year. He wanted to come up with a gift that he could give to his new teammates. In an effort to gain friendships and build comradery among the players, he designed a baseball-style hat with the word "Cincy" and began to share them one-by-one. Soon local sports reporters were asking players about the hats, having never seen the Cincy design before. The unique hats began to get noticed and requests for the hats grew, even garnering national attention. Ted decided to produce a larger quantity of hats and make them available to the public with all proceeds going to support Village of Merici.

Ted wore a Cincy hat with every interview and talked up the project throughout the season. Village of Merici became command central and handled the fulfillment for all orders, shipping hats to every state in the nation and to a few countries overseas. Within ten weeks, over 6,100 hats were sold!

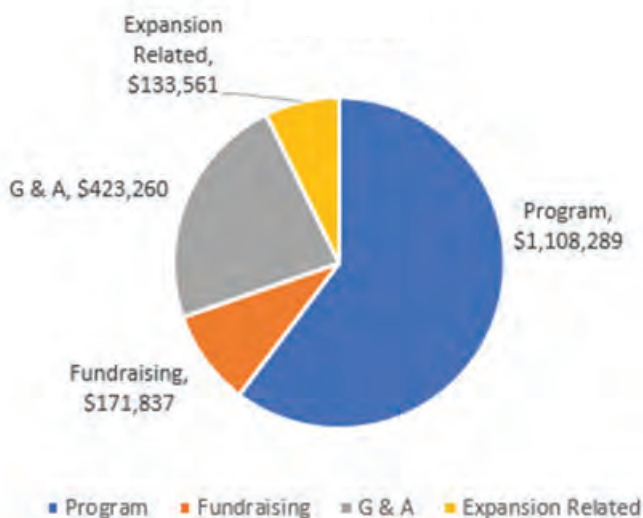

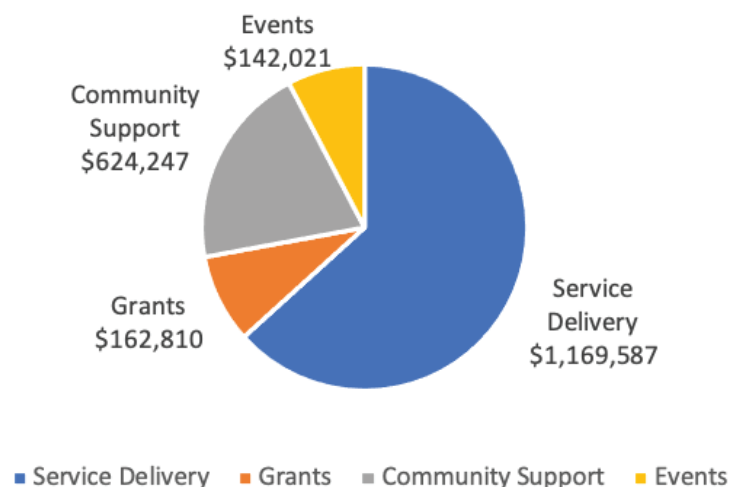

Spotlight on Affordable Housing

Affordable housing is at a crisis for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities in Indiana and particularly in the Indianapolis area. Funding for development of independent living apartments or homes is limited and rent rates are reaching record high levels. Adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities are typically below 30% of the area median income levels which keeps them at extreme poverty levels with income levels below \$15,000 annually. At Village of Merici we are committed to partnering with developers to offer low-income housing so adults with IDD have the same opportunities as others to live in the community. It takes donors and grantors to help make independent living a reality.

Carmel location set to open:

Great progress is being made on the North End build, a partnership between Old Town Companies and Village of Merici. This integrated community in Carmel, a mix of differing housing options, will offer 40 apartments for adults with disabilities, creating the first affordable housing in Carmel.

Due to the extreme need, there is a long list of applicants, far surpassing the 40 units. The occupancy waiting list for this location is now closed. Doors will open on this new community mid-summer.

Opening in 2024:



Lawrence location:

The second location in Lawrence, Brunette Apartments, is also moving forward. The internal demolition is now complete. After a slow building compliance process through the Department of Natural Resources who maintains oversight of all the historic buildings on Lawton Loop, we plan to get underway with the renovation to the building as soon as possible. This building, which once housed two companies of military personnel, will be transformed into 38 affordable apartments for adults with disabilities.

There are currently over 200 individuals on the waiting list for this building which will be completed in 2024.

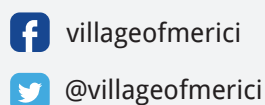
